The Dole Institute of Politics at the University of Kansas is announcing a Research Fellowship for the 2009-2010 academic year. Graduate students and post-doctoral scholars are eligible to apply for this one-time \$2,500 award which will support substantial contributions to the study of Congress, politics or policy issues.

Scholars will have full access to Senator Bob Dole's extensive collections which document his 36 year career in the House and Senate and provide significant documentation on specific legislative issues. Applicants are encouraged to browse the Dole Archive database or consult a Dole Archivist for specific collections information.

The successful fellow will be required to conduct research at the Dole Archive for a period of 1-3 weeks. In addition, the Fellow will be required to submit a final copy of any thesis, dissertation, article or book produced through the Fellowship as well as submitting to the Dole Institute a 500-1000 word statement describing the research conducted here that will be used by the Dole Institute for print and electronic dissemination.

In order to apply for a 2009-2010 Research Fellowship please submit:

1. Completed Fellowship Application
2. One-five page research proposal which introduces your topic of research, indicates how this research project falls within the body of historical literature and address specifically how the Dole Archive may contribute to this research. Please also include possible areas of publication for your research.
3. Resume or Curriculum Vita
4. Letter of reference
