PERMISSION TO EXAMINE

Permission to examine material will be granted to researchers upon completion of the application form and agreement to abide by the following rules governing the use of materials:

PROTECTION OF THE MATERIAL

- All briefcases, purses, coats and personal articles are to be deposited in the lockers provided. The Dole Institute is not responsible for any personal items which are lost or stolen.
- A researcher is responsible for the safeguarding of any archival materials made available to him/her in the reading room.
- Researchers may not remove materials from the reading room for any purpose or rearrange the order in which they are delivered.
- The use of any kind of pen is prohibited. Manuscripts may not be leaned on, written on, folded, or handled in any way likely to damage them. In certain cases researchers may be required to use reproductions of materials.
- Eating and smoking are prohibited in the reading room.
- The Dole Institute Archive reserves the right to inspect all research material and all personal articles before a patron leaves the reading room.

PERMISSION TO PUBLISH

- **Important: Permission to examine materials is not an authorization to publish them.**
- Separate written application for permission to publish must be made to the *Robert J. Dole Institute of Politics*. Researchers who plan eventual publication of their work should make inquiry concerning overall restriction on publication before beginning their research.
- To the extent that it may properly do so, the *Robert J. Dole Institute of Politics* will ordinarily grant the usual publication rights to applicants. However, in granting permission to publish, the Institute does not surrender its own right thereafter to publish any of the materials from its collection or grant permission to

- others to publish them. If permission to publish is granted, the location of the cited material shall be indicated in the published work.
- Please be advised that researchers are not permitted to use names or addresses of constituents when citing quotations from correspondence. Reference may be made instead to “a farmer in western Kansas,” or a “teacher in Riley County,” etc. Please feel free to ask Archivist if in doubt.
 - A free copy of all publications that rely heavily on the *Robert J. Dole Papers* should be presented to the *Robert J. Dole Institute of Politics* as soon as the work is published. The Archive does not assume any responsibility for infringement of copyright in the material held by others.

Such permissions are granted subject to whatever restrictions may have been placed on the material by the donors or depositors.

DUPLICATION POLICY

- The *Robert J. Dole Institute of Politics* will consider requests for the duplication of material when such duplication can be done without injury to the material, and does not violate copyright restrictions.
