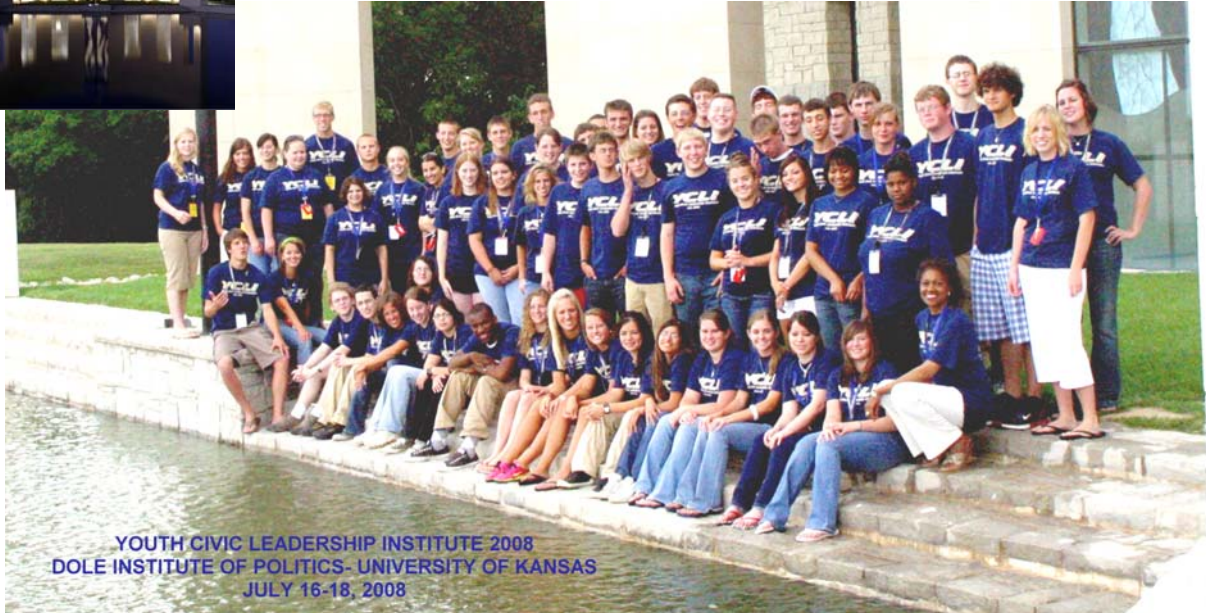

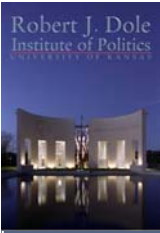

Depart for Topeka/State Capitol program, Leadership at Work: Meeting with Legislators. Experience Kansas Senate Chamber with **Sen. John Vratil** - Vice Pres. of Senate. Experience House Chamber with **Rep. Ray Merrick** – Majority Leader and **Rep. Jim Ward** – Asst. Minority Leader. Meet with several state legislators. Discuss “Why Public Service?.” Climb to top of Capitol Dome. Return to Dole Institute for YCLI reception and dinner with **Friends of the Dole Institute** (Program: A Conversation with Student Leaders).
